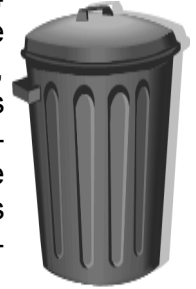

Just a few reminders...

- Beginning on November 15, no parking is allowed on any City street between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. to allow for snow removal. This parking restriction will be in effect until March 15, 2019.
- The City of South Haven mailed the Winter 2019 Property Tax bills the first week of December. If you have not received your bill please call (269) 637-0700 or visit the Parcel Records area of the City's website at www.south-haven.com. **Winter taxes are due on February 14.**

- You may notice that all bills from the City now contain a barcode. Please make sure to bring your bill with you when you make a payment to ensure proper posting of your payment and to expedite your service.
- Trash containers should not be placed in the parkway more than 24 hours before pick-up. Also, the containers shall be removed no more than 24 hours following pick-up.



SHAES Citizen Fire Academy

South Haven Area Emergency Services will be conducting its third Citizen Fire Academy beginning March 20. The department is looking for up to 15 South Haven area residents who would like to learn what it takes to be a firefighter. This is not a certification course, but all students will leave having gained skills that may save a life, along with having a better understanding of the fire department's capabilities. This Academy is held every two years. The last Academy was held in 2017.



The Academy is open to anyone 18 years of age or older who lives in the greater South Haven community. Due to the physical nature of this program, interested parties are strongly encouraged to consult with their physician prior to applying. Physical activities will include, but are not limited to: lifting of heavy tools, wearing heavy equipment, kneeling, crawling, pulling, pushing and having a great time while doing it all.

Classes will be held primarily on Wednesday evenings starting March 20 at 6:30 p.m. and continuing until May 8. Three classes will be held on Saturday mornings (March 23, April 13, and April 27).

Skills will include rope rescue, vehicle extrication, fire extinguishers, CPR, home safety inspections and structural firefighting.
