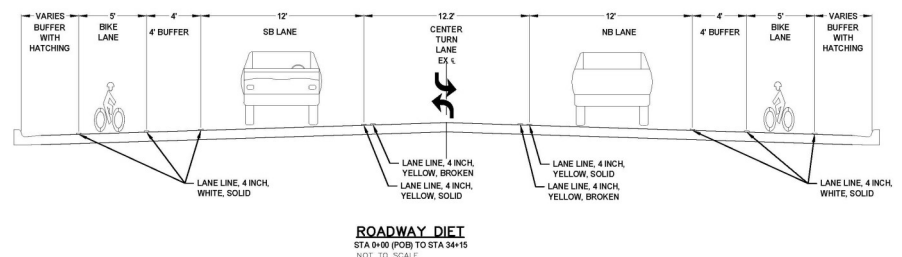
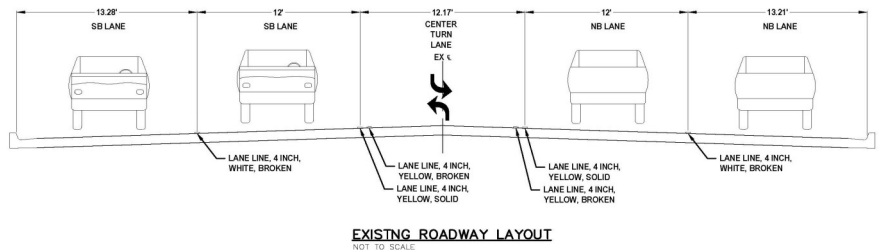


## I-196 Business Loop Road Diet

The City of South Haven is finalizing its public input process for the implementation of a "road diet" through the Broadway Street/La Grange Street corridor from Phoenix Road to Aylworth Avenue. The project is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2019.

Over the past few years, the City of South Haven has undertaken a study and sought public input on the project before pursuing the implementation of a road diet. It should be noted that this first phase is a planned trial phase to ensure the proposed road diet functions as anticipated and will simply entail restriping the road. No permanent changes will be made to the existing infrastructure until after the trial period is over and the functionality of the street evaluated and additional public comment solicited.

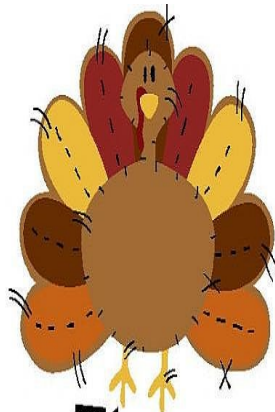

Just a few reminders...

- The City of South Haven Code of Ordinance states that trash containers may be placed on the curb no more than 24 hours prior to trash pick-up, and removed no more than 24 hours after trash pick-up.
- Every person who owns, occupies or leases any land within the city must cut, destroy, and remove all noxious and poisonous weeds growing on the property, as well as dead grass and brush. The resident must also prevent grass from growing in excess of nine inches in height.
- South Haven City Hall will be closed on **Thursday, November 22**, and **Friday, November 23** in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.



# Happy Thanksgiving

Beginning on November 15th, there is **no parking allowed on any City street between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.** to allow for snow removal. This parking restriction will be in effect until March 15, 2019.



The City of South Haven will mail Winter Property Tax bills to city residents on December 1, 2018. If you have not received your bill by December 20, please call the Customer Service Manager at (269) 637-0706. Winter taxes are due on February 14, 2018.



Daylight Savings time ends at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 4, 2018. Clocks should be set back 1 hour.
