### Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Report Summary - MPSC Case Number U□18313

The City of South Haven independently administered the EWR efforts in order to comply with 2008 PA-295, as amended by 2016 PA-342.

In 2017 the City of South Haven spent \$234,953 on EWR Programs and achieved 1,774 MWh of energy savings.

MMEA filed a joint 2017 EWR Annual Report for the City of South Haven with the MPSC on May 31, 2018.

### Renewable Energy Report Annual Summary – MPSC Case Number U-16631

The City of South Haven has taken the following actions to comply with the REP standards:

Filed a 20-year Renewable Energy Plan (REP) with the MPSC on March 31, 2009 as required by PA 295. The REP was found to be in compliance on July 1, 2009.

The City of South Haven filed a Biennial Review of REP on January 10, 2018 and was found to be in compliance by MPSC on April 12, 2018.

The City of South Haven acquired from Renewable Energy Systems during the reporting period 13,496 MWh of Renewable Energy. The City of South Haven acquired 13,496 Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) for the 2017 reporting period. The table below shows the Incremental Cost of Compliance with state law 2008 PA-295, as amended by 2016 PA-342 for 2017 and the anticipated Cost of Compliance with 2016 PA-342 for 2018.

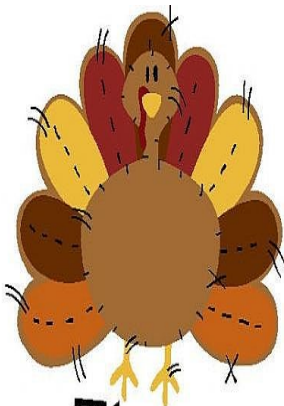

As a reminder, fall leaf pickup is underway. Please be patient and remember that a leaf truck is a large vehicle and cannot turn around easily. The street crew will complete one side of the street and come back to do the other side, which may occur on a different day.

Also, in an effort to assist the city street crew, please remember to rake your leaves to the parkway (the area between the sidewalk and the street). **Please do not rake them into the street.** This will clog storm drains and also make it difficult for the leaf truck to pick up your leaves.
