Detention Basin Catches Overflow

During the week of February 19th, Southwest Michigan was hit with a deluge of rain, with some areas reporting more than three inches over a span of just a day and a half. The heavy rain, coupled with a rapid melt-off of snowpack, resulted in localized flooding. As a result, the city's Wastewater Treatment Plant experienced high sewer flow conditions. During the rainy period, the city's staff was able to use the new detention basin at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Staff was able to route more than one million gallons of flow into the detention basin for storage and treatment. This process ensured that an overflow into the Black River did not occur. Below is an image of the basin (aerial image provided by SHAES staff using the organization's drone) that was captured on Wednesday, February 21st.
