Public Works Projects Around the City

Recently, the Department of Public Works (DPW) sent public notices related to the “Core City Secondary Upgrade, Phase IV Electrical Project.” The DPW has sent notices to the property owners who have homes or businesses located near the area of the planned project. The notice describes the plan to replace existing electrical system facilities within the Phase IV area. The project is anticipated to begin construction in February 2019, and is scheduled for completion by June 28, 2019. The project will involve upgrading and replacing existing facilities as well as the installation of new electrical facilities at needed locations.

Additionally, the DPW has also sent notices on the “76th Street Rebuild Electrical Project.” The DPW has sent notices to the property owners who have homes or businesses located near the area of the planned project. The notice describes the plan to replace existing electrical system facilities within the 76th Street rebuild area. The project is anticipated to begin construction in February 2019, and is scheduled for completion by June 28, 2019. The project will involve upgrading and replacing existing facilities as well as the installation of new electrical facilities at needed locations.

Finally, the City of South Haven has realized that certain repairs are needed throughout Lake View Cemetery to extend the lifetime of the cemetery and associated infrastructure. The City of is seeking bids for proposed improvements at the Cemetery. The proposals are to be opened on February 26th, 2019. The improvements include:

- Installation of 30-yard hydrants. These hydrants will replace existing ones.
- Demolition of the cemetery office structure & garage.
- Repairs and improvements to existing walls within the cemetery.
- Landscaping improvements.
- Decorative entry signs off from Blue Star Highway.
