Short-Term Rental Reminder

As the summer season approaches, the City of South Haven wants to remind visitors and residents of the rules governing short-term rentals, as well as draw attention to its Good Neighbor Guide to ensure a safe and enjoyable summer season.

The Good Neighbor Guide draws on established City ordinances to provide guidelines for renters and residents to follow. Failure to comply may result in notification of law enforcement and/or a fine. These guidelines include:

- Between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m., no shouting, whistling, yelling or singing on public streets. This ordinance does not prohibit normal conversation outdoors. Please use your discretion and be respectful to neighbors with regard to voice volume.
- Fireworks are not permitted on short-term rental properties, unless occupied by the owner and in accordance with City ordinance.
- Parking is limited in some areas. Please use off-street parking when available. Do not block sidewalks, mailboxes or driveways. From Nov. 15 to March 15, overnight street parking is prohibited.
- Garbage must be in proper containers for pick up on Monday and may not be placed for pickup before Sunday.
- Pets are required to be on leashes when not in enclosed areas. All animal waste should be picked up and disposed of properly. Reunions, weddings and other large events are subject to individual vacation home policies. Check with your landlord.
- Limit swimming, umbrella or blanket activities on beaches to public areas only. Violators of these regulations may result in notification of law enforcement and/or fines.
