Weather Buoy Deployed

As summer approaches, the City of South Haven is preparing for the beach and boating season. At the end of April, the weather buoy was deployed into Lake Michigan, which provides continuous updates on air and water conditions. The buoy provides interested parties with readings of a air and water temperatures, wind speed, wave height, barometric pressure, wind speeds and directions, and other information useful to beachgoers and boaters.
