## Master Plan Public Hearing Set for June 26

The City of South Haven Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall 539 Phoenix Street South Haven, MI 49090, for the purpose of receiving comments on the proposed update to the Master Plan.

The proposed plan is a comprehensive document, long-range in its view, and includes specific goals, objectives, and strategies regarding the future of the community. Per the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, (Public Act 33 of 2008, as amended), the plan is intended to serve as a guide for future decision-making related to community development. It was last updated in 2012. By statute the Planning Commission may, at or following said public hearing, recommend approval to the City Council the proposed plan as drafted or as may be modified as a result of public comments.

## Local Fireworks Restrictions

State of Michigan law allows for the use of consumer fireworks on the day preceding, the day of, and the day after a national holiday with the following restrictions:

- ◆ No fireworks are allowed between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.;
- ◆ Fireworks are not to be exploded on streets or in the city parks, parking lots, beaches, or marinas;
- ◆ Fireworks are not to be exploded by those under the age of 18; and
- ◆ Fireworks are not to be used by those under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Low impact fireworks and novelties such as sparklers, party poppers, smoke balls and smoke cones and not regulated and may be used year round. Violations of the above are civil infractions and may carry a fine of up to \$500.00. Violators can also be held responsible for property damage resulting from fireworks.
