SNOWMOBILES ALLOWED IN THE CITY OF SOUTH HAVEN

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – (South Haven, Michigan) Discussions among city staff and elected officials have led to designated snowmobile access routes in the City of South Haven. Snowmobiles were not previously allowed in the city.

Snowmobilers may now enter the City from the Kal-Haven Trail and operate snowmobiles from the Kal-Haven Trailhead on North Bailey Street, along Wells and Dunkley Streets to the Depot RV Park parking lot north of the Depot Store.

The snowmobile access routes will also allow for a route to access to the gas station at the corner of 73rd and Phoenix Street, and to hotels on Veterans Blvd and Dewey Court.

The City has designated the following routes as snowmobile access routes:

2nd Avenue between 71 ½ Street and 73rd Street
Veterans Boulevard between 2nd Avenue and Phoenix Street
73rd Street between 2nd Avenue and Phoenix Street.
Dewey Court east from Veterans Boulevard
N. Bailey Street from the Kal-Haven Trail Head to Wells Street
Wells Street to Dunkley Street
Dunkley Street to the Depot Parking Lot

Snowmobiles may operate on these streets during the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 11:59 p.m. All City ordinances, including speed and noise are in effect.

The snowmobile access routes are in place during the current winter season. The City will evaluate the issues regarding snowmobile operation and the economic impact snowmobiles have on the community prior to making a permanent decision regarding the matter.
