RE: SRF #5602-01 North Shore Drive Project Update

North Shore Drive Project

As you may have noticed, construction has resumed on our North Shore Drive project in South Haven. This past week, Milbocker & Sons has been continuing construction on the new beach access stairs at the end of Newcome Street. Their carpenters have indicated that this work should be complete by the end of this week, or first part of next week at the latest. Relocation of other utilities (electric, phone, and cable) continues to progress along the length of our project.

The remaining underground utility work within the Phase III (Brockway to Baseline) section of our project has also resumed. Currently, Milbocker is working on the installation of the new storm sewer located within the Newcome Street right-of-way. This storm sewer has been installed from the bluff back to the street and is currently being backfilled with sand.

Tomorrow or Friday, North Shore Drive will be closed in the vicinity of Newcome as the contractor needs to install the new storm sewer to the east side North Shore Drive. Once this crossing is complete, the portion of North Shore Drive which will be unpassable (due to storm sewer construction) will progress north toward Baseline Road. Placement of the upcoming storm sewer and later sanitary sewer, will impact through traffic movement as the sewers are fairly deep. If you notice heavy machinery working in the direction of your travel, use an alternate route as through access during the daytime will be very hit or miss. Along with the storm sewer construction next



week, Milbocker also plans on replacing sanitary service laterals to east side homes as they progress northerly. These services are planned to be replaced and temporarily tied back into the existing service until the new sanitary sewer is installed.

Lastly, our weekly on-site "tailgate talks" have resumed. For anyone with specific project related questions, these meetings take place on Wednesday's at 9:30 a.m. on the sidewalk in front of North Side Memories on Dyckman Avenue.
